

## Casey Costigan

Casey Costigan attended Indiana University from 1984-1988. He then attended Western Michigan/Thomas M. Cooley Law School where he graduated in 1991.

Following law school, he joined the law firm of Costigan & Wollrab, P.C. He practiced in the area of Civil Litigation for 15 years before he was appointed as an Associate Circuit Judge for the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit in 2006.

As an Associate Judge, he spent 5 years presiding over criminal cases and 2 years presiding over family cases.

In 2014, the Illinois Supreme Court appointed him a Circuit Judge and in 2016 he was elected to retain that position.

For the last 3 years, he has presided over a criminal felony docket and has recently taken over as presiding judge of the McLean County Drug Court.

He is active as a community volunteer in the Bloomington/Normal community as well as serving on statewide committees for the Illinois Judiciary.

He is a frequent presenter of the award winning program *7 Reasons to Leave the Party*, which details the legal consequences of underage drinking and drug usage to high school students.
