

Judge Pablo Eves graduated from the University of Missouri in 1994 and received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Illinois College of Law in 1998. He was appointed as an Associate Circuit Judge for the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit of Illinois in 2015. He currently sits in the criminal division in McLean County assigned to the Major Traffic courtroom.
