### **Veterans Justice Outreach:**

#### **Allows justice involved Veterans opportunity to address needs of:**

- Psychiatric/mental health
- Medical needs
- Substance use difficulties
- Homelessness/ housing needs
- Employment obstacles
- Financial needs
- Application for Service Connected disabilities
- Educational goals

#### **Available clinical treatment options:**

- Psychiatric inpatient unit
- Residential Substance treatment – 3-4 weeks at length
- Psychosocial Residential Rehabilitation Program (PRRTP) in Danville (1-6 months)
- Residential intensive PTSD/MH programs
- Outpatient MH services (indiv & groups)
- Outpatient substance use services (indiv & groups)
- Outpatient psychological treatment (indiv & groups)
- **Local Vet Center** – MH/ sub use tx; readjustment counseling (indiv & groups) (upon availability and location)

#### **Evidence Based Practices used by Department of Veterans Affairs (EBP)**

- EBP Psychotherapies
- Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT) - PTSD
- Prolonged Exposure therapy (PE) – PTSD
- Social Skills Training (SST) – schizophrenia and other SMI
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (indiv & groups) – Depression
- Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT) - Depression
- Mental Health Intensive Case Mgmt (MHICM) Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) – cs mgmt for Depression/Schizophrenia and other SMI
- Interpersonal Therapy (IPT) - Depression
