

**ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019 - 13**

**CIRCUIT CLERKS OF THE ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT APPOINTED  
AS RECEIVER AND REMITTER OF SERVICE PROVIDER COSTS**

Pursuant to 705 ILCS 135/5-15 (P.A. 100-0987) providing that the defendant shall pay service provider costs to the entity that provided the service; and that, under the Act, said costs are not eligible for credit for time served, substitution of community service, and/or waiver; and further, Section 5-15 provides that the Circuit Court may, through administrative order, appoint the Circuit Clerk as the receiver and remitter of certain service provider costs, which may include, but are not limited to, probation fees, traffic school fees, and/or drug or alcohol testing fees, the Court makes the following finding:


For the purposes of efficiency, collection and reporting capability, and uniformity, designating the Circuit Clerk as the receiver and remitter of service provider costs is a more effective way to collect these costs than having the defendant pay service providers directly.

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

The Circuit Clerks of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit are hereby appointed as the receiver and remitter of service provider costs in their respective counties, which may include, but are not limited to, probation fees, traffic school fees, and/or drug or alcohol testing fees.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Order shall be effective July 1, 2019 and until further order of this Court.
