
**EMERGENCY ORDER – COVID-19
TEMPORARY ORDER REGARDING NOTICES TO APPEAR
ON CERTAIN NON-FELONY CASES**

With respect to any warrant issued in relation to a civil, family, ordinance violation, traffic or misdemeanor offense, **except** offenses of domestic battery or violation of an order of protection, it is hereby administratively ordered that the law enforcement officer may satisfy the obligation of the warrant by issuing the defendant an notice to appear no less than 42 days or more than 63 days from the date of contact.

Any provision(s) of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit Court Administrative Order 2020-06 not in conflict with this Order shall remain in full force and effect. The court will continue to review and adjust the order as is necessary.

This Order is effective from March 25, 2020 – May 1, 2020.
