ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020 - 11**

2020 LOGAN COUNTY JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENTS

This order supersedes all previous judicial assignment orders for Logan County, IL. The following assignments shall be in effect in the Logan County Circuit Court of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, commencing **March 30, 2020**, and said assignments shall continue in full force and effect until modified by a subsequent assignment order:

LOGAN COUNTY

Presiding Judge: Jonathan C. Wright, Resident Circuit Judge
Thomas W. Funk, Associate Circuit Judge
Charles Feeney, Circuit Judge
William Workman, Associate Circuit Judge

IT IS ORDERED all cases filed in any county in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit subject to the provisions of 750 ILCS 70 et al. (*Judicial Waiver of Notice of Abortion*) shall be consolidated before the McLean County Circuit Court as provided by local administrative order 2013-29; and


All Veteran's Treatment Court cases filed in any county in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit on or after February 4, 2019 are assigned to Judge Charles M. Feeney III (Woodford County) unless assigned by interchange to a judge within the county of filing; and

1. Judge Jonathan Wright is hereby assigned to all cases in the following case categories: AD, CF, ED, J, JA, JD, L, MH, MR related to SVP cases, MR cases related to extradition or expungement, P, Tax, the odd-numbered D or OP cases and to the Logan County Drug Court. Any of the cases within these case categories previously assigned to Judge William G. Workman are hereby assigned to Judge Jonathan Wright by interchange unless specifically retained by Judge Workman as provided below.
2. Judge Thomas W. Funk is hereby assigned to all cases in the following case categories: CH, CL, CM, CV, DT, F, LM, MR cases not listed above, OV, SC, TR, the even-numbered D or OP cases and those D or F cases involving IV-D child support enforcement with the Attorney General's office. Any of the cases within these case categories previously assigned to Judge William G. Workman or Judge Jonathan Wright are hereby assigned to Judge Thomas Funk by interchange unless specifically retained by the previous judge as provided below.

3. Judge William G. Workman and Judge Jonathan C. Wright will be assigned by Judge Jonathon C. Wright to those cases which each Judge is currently assigned and for which each is required to retain for trial and disposition.
4. Judge Charles Feeney is the Presiding Judge of the Marriage Division and is hereby assigned all marriages and civil unions.
5. Judge Jonathon C. Wright, Judge William C. Workman and Judge Thomas W. Funk remain assigned to all cases previously and specifically assigned to them by the Chief Judge not otherwise provided for in this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the judges of Logan County assigned in this Order are each assigned any Contempt of Court case arising out of a case assigned to that particular judge.
