**ORDER AMENDING 2020 McLEAN COUNTY JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENTS**

The following assignments shall be in effect in the Circuit Court of McLean County of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit as of **March 30, 2020**, and shall continue until modified by subsequent Administrative Order.

**CRIMINAL DIVISION**

It is ORDERED that Judge William G. Workman is assigned all Criminal Misdemeanor cases currently assigned to Judge Scott E. Kording him and all such cases filed on or after March 30, 2020 and all Miscellaneous Remedy cases involving the expungement of criminal records currently assigned to Judge Scott E. Kording and all such filed on or after March 30, 2020.

Judge William G. Workman is assigned all Criminal Protective Orders currently assigned to Judge Scott E. Kording and Judge Thomas W. Funk and to all such cases filed on or after March 30, 2020.

Judge Scott E. Kording will be assigned cases by the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division for which Judge Scott E. Kording was previously assigned and for which he is required to retain for trial or disposition. Judge Scott E. Kording also remains assigned to all cases previously and specifically assigned to him by the Chief Judge not otherwise provided for in this Order.

**FAMILY DIVISION**

It is ORDERED that Judge Scott E. Kording is assigned all IV-D Family cases currently assigned to Judge Thomas W. Funk and all IV-D Family cases filed on or after March 30, 2020.


It is further ORDERED that Judge Scott E. Kording is assigned all Family cases currently assigned to Judge Thomas W. Funk and all Family cases filed on or after March 30, 2020. Judge Kording will also be assigned to Divorce ("D") cases as determined by the Presiding Judge of the Family Division.

It is ORDERED that Judge Scott E. Kording is assigned all Emergency and Plenary Order of Protection or Civil No-Contact cases filed on or after March 30, 2020 and to all Emergency or Plenary Orders of Protection previously assigned to Judge Thomas W. Funk.

It is ORDERED that Judge Thomas W. Funk will be assigned cases by the Presiding Judge of the Family Division for which Judge Thomas W. Funk was previously assigned and for which he is required to retain for trial or disposition.

The Court may amend these assignments as needed without additional notice.
