2021 McLEAN COUNTY JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENTS - AMENDED

Effective February 12, 2021, the following assignments are amended and shall be in effect in the Circuit Court of McLean County of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit and shall continue until modified by subsequent Administrative Order. The remainder of Administrative Order 2019-33 (*McLean County Judicial Assignments*) remains in effect unless otherwise amended.

A. CIVIL DIVISION

Mark A. Fellheimer, Circuit Judge

1. Judge Mark A. Fellheimer is assigned all Law Magistrate, Small Claims and Mandatory Arbitration cases currently assigned to Judge Scott J. Black, and all Law Magistrate, Small Claims and Mandatory Arbitration cases filed on or after February 12, 2021. Judge Fellheimer is appointed as Supervising Judge of Arbitration for McLean County.

B. CRIMINAL DIVISION:

Scott J. Black, Associate Circuit Judge



William G. Workman, Associate Circuit Judge

1. Judge William G. Workman is assigned all Criminal Felony cases presently assigned to him and any Criminal Felony cases assigned to him by the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division on or after February 12, 2021.
2. Additionally, all Felony Arraignment proceedings in all criminal felony cases are assigned to Judge William G. Workman effective February 12, 2021.
3. Judge Scott J. Black is assigned all pending Criminal Misdemeanor cases assigned to other judges under Administrative Order 2020-33 and all such cases filed on or after February 12, 2021, and all Miscellaneous Remedy cases involving the expungement of criminal records currently assigned to Judge Workman and all such cases filed on or after February 12, 2021.
4. Judge Mark A. Fellheimer is assigned all Ordinance Violation cases currently assigned to him or Judge Scott J. Black and all such cases filed on or after February 12, 2021.

5. All Associate Circuit Judges are assigned to hear pre-arraignment hearings on all Criminal Division cases (CF, CM, DT, TR, OV, Extradition Miscellaneous Remedy and OP).
6. The Judges assigned to this Division shall hear such other cases as may, from time to time, be assigned to them by the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division, or by interchange agreement of said judges.
7. The Judges assigned to this division are each assigned any Contempt of Court case arising out of a case assigned to that particular judge.
