

**ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT (IL)
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2024 – 18**

COURT HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR 2025

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- A. The Eleventh Judicial Circuit Court, having adopted the 2025 holiday schedule established by the Illinois Supreme Court, shall adjourn, and the offices of the Circuit Clerk shall not accept filings on the following legal holidays for the year 2025 as amended:

New Year's Day	Wednesday, January 1
Martin Luther King Day	Monday, January 20
Lincoln's Birthday	Wednesday, February 12
President's Day	Monday, February 17
Memorial Day	Monday, May 26
Juneteenth Independence Day	Thursday, June 19
Independence Day	Friday, July 4
Labor Day	Monday, September 1
Columbus Day (Observed)	Monday, October 13
Veterans' Day	Tuesday, November 11
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 27
Thanksgiving Holiday	Friday, November 28
Christmas Day	Thursday, December 25

- B. All matters returnable on said legal holidays shall be continued to the next business day of said court.
- C. The time for filing all motions and pleadings shall be extended to the next business day of said court.
- D. There shall be a court holiday in any county in this Circuit if the court facilities in that county are closed for observance of a holiday not listed above. These additional observances shall be limited to only those situations in which both court security is unavailable and all county government offices are closed.
- E. In the event the court facilities in a county are to remain open on one or more of the holidays above, and the Chief Judge may disregard the listed holiday and declare the court open on that day.
