

Thomas McClure is the Director of Legal Studies and an associate professor of Politics and Government at Illinois State University. Prior to entering academia as a full-time professor, he served as a judicial law clerk for the Illinois Appellate Court for two years and engaged in the private practice of law for 26 years.
