

Children's Home & Aid **Family Visitation Center (FVC)** is expanding services for families experiencing domestic violence, dating violence, child sexual abuse, sexual assault, and stalking.

With the Justice for Families Program Grant through the Department of Justice Office on Violence Against Women (OVW), the FVC will provide 35 weekly supervised visitations and safe exchanges. The FVC offers a safe, child-friendly setting at 403 S. State St. in Bloomington, IL. The FVC incorporates safety features and protocols to ensure meetings between children and parents are nurturing and protected from violence. Although Children's Home & Aid has a long history of providing this service to McLean County residents, the grant will now allow families throughout the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, which includes Ford, Livingston, Logan, and Woodford counties, to also participate.

Besides family programming, Children's Home & Aid will also facilitate annual trauma sensitivity trainings for court-based and court-related personnel. In addition, brown bag lunch trainings will be offered to judges, attorneys and court personnel.

The three year grant will commence on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. Children's Home & Aid will host a FVC Open House at 403 S. State St. in Bloomington, IL on October 24<sup>th</sup> from 12pm - 2pm. It will be an opportunity to meet the team, tour the facility and learn more about services.

We are excited to offer these newly expanded services to continue to support children, youth and families to thrive in strong communities.
