Kristin Alferink currently works as an Assistant State's Attorney specializing in sexual assault cases. Kristin leads the McLean County Sexual Assault Task Force, a multidisciplinary team focused on tackling issues related to the investigation and prosecution of sex crimes. During her career she has also prosecuted murder, weapons offenses, home invasion, residential burglary and weapons offenses. In addition to working as a prosecutor, Kristin also worked for the Illinois Attorney General's Office and the Illinois State Board of Education. While at the Illinois Attorney General's Office, Kristin defended the State of Illinois in various types of litigation, spanning from property claims filed by incarcerated individuals in the Illinois Court of Claims to employment discrimination claims in Federal Court. While at the State Board of Education, Kristin provided in house counsel regarding labor and employment matters and also represented the Agency during arbitrations, matters before the Illinois Human Rights Commission and the Illinois Labor Relations Board.
